Long vowel sounds CCVC CCCVC CCV CCVCC
Phase 4 words ending -s /s/ Phase 4 words ending -s /z/ Phase 4 words ending -es longer words
root word ending in: -ing, -ed /t/, -ed /id/ /ed/, -ed /d/
root word ending in: -er, -est longer words

Reading

We will continue to read with your child weekly and send home the book that your child has practised in class.

We expect the children to reread the sentences in their books with fluency and begin to use expression

We hope by the end of term the children will be reading many words automatically.

Please practice reading at home as much as possible with your child to help them become confident fluent readers.
